Music started at at 7:pm and finished at 11:30pm.


Music from Marion's Outlaws, Double Dare, and some of our top Woodend Beach Country Music Club singers meant plenty of variety.

Singer Protocol WBCMC

Some suggestions for executing a smooth and consistent introduction to your performance:

1/ It would be great if you provide at least 4 copies of your chord sheets, preferably individually attached to a single manila folder, those Books some of you have just do not work for the band.

2/ When you get up to the stage tell the RHYTHM GUITARIST what you are singing, the key you are sing it in and if there are any band members you do not want to accompany you. He(she) will communicate with the rest of the band.

3/. Keep the introduction to a minimum, most of us do not care who wrote it, sang it or when, there is a good chance most already know anyway. The delay here is where most time is lost causing the necessity for some singers only getting one shot.

4/ Please don't be miffed if you are asked to sing just one song when time is restricted, time is the non variable. Also if or when we get an unexpected guest of really good talent please allow the committee to give them an unscheduled extended spot, it is a welcoming gesture on our part and it provides quality variation to our evening, it could mean you are asked not to sing at all that night.

5/ The front seat row will be kept free so please use this to sit in when the singer before you is performing so we keep the flow going
